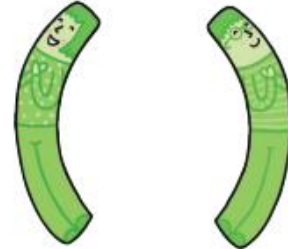


## Parentheses/Brackets
